Manager's Korner

Hi to all, as well as Good Bye to many of those leaving us for the season. This is bit of a follow-up from last months managers letter. If you haven't read it, I suggest you do. As we know all too well, in getting older we have bitter sweet moments in our lives, and after experiencing one I feel exactly that way. For St Patrick's day I was invited to an old-fashioned Hippie weekend on a friend's wonderful farm in Old Town Florida. About 15 of us had an awesome weekend away. A nice 4-mile hike - huge night time fires- peace and quiet. The farm is a nature farm, and my friends who live on it (8 now) are like a self-sustainable little commune. They all chip in and work the farm and my friend- the owner- has 4+ acres irrigated and is growing stuff to sell and support more people living there - no fertilizers- no chemicals - all 100% natural. They went foraging through the nature trails and picked some mushrooms - and some green stuff that I never heard of that they threw in a morning frittata - was awesome. The sweet part of life. Unfortunately, through this all - I got a call from the hospital just as we were getting in the car to go up to the farm. One of my all-time best friends passed away - he had a heart attack - his 5th or 6th one. He had fallen on hard times later in life and was left with what I thought was nothing - only 1 family member left - a sister- wanted nothing to do with a call about his death - and as far as I know only 3 people, including me, he called friends. I used to play golf and fish, kayak and laugh endlessly with him - I've known him for 20 years from my old Home Depot days. Over the last 5 years we have made many long-lasting memories to add to the first 15 years of our friendship.

He left some contact info and some directions on what to do with his stuff. Most of it donated to charities, as little as it was. That, along with 2 suicide notes and a thank you to his friends for giving him the strength to stick around after the 1st heart attack - 5 years ago. Something we never knew but none the less a last "thank you" from an old friend.

He wrote about cherishing our friendship and the love he felt later in life that he never experienced before. He made it sound like he had everything in life, and he loved to share that love and endless laughs. He was richer than I ever thought. So, what I thought was the bitter end to the "bitter end" cliché, turned out to be a sweet part of the "bitter sweet" cliché and a humbling experience about what is important in our lives. Unfortunately, we find out so much about life through death.

I will have the opportunity to tell our stories and live those forever moments we made whenever.

We have discussed, along with the Board from Tarpon Shores, the recent conversations about the Mango road project. We have plans to meet with the Project Administrator for the City about this project. Discussion is to widen the road, which was originally not in the plans but that has seemed to change daily. We have had many discussions about our water leak issues, and we are investigating that much more seriously. Once we get a firm direction we will discuss much further with the residents.

I have also been contacted by realtors for units 221 and 235 as well as Unit 90 but have not received any info on those yet.

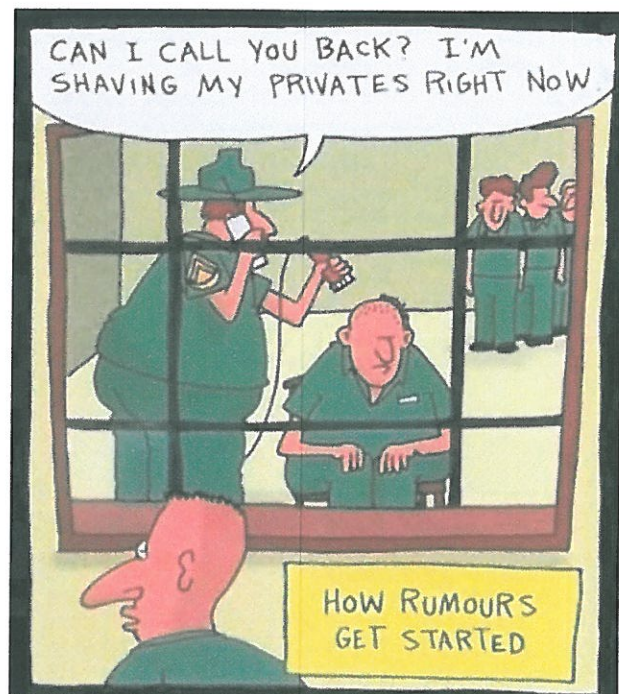


Springtime reminders and work

NOTE: Prior to leaving, you should have made arrangements with someone to **ACTIVELY** weed & trim your garden flower beds (if applicable), also to clean out your gutters of any collecting debris and keep you informed if any other maintenance issues need attention. Make sure the person you choose has general operational knowledge of your *sprinkler* system. WEEKLY system checks include:

- 1) Ensure proper time, date & zone watering schedule (City/County restrictions may apply)
- 2) Run the sprinkler system manually to ensure proper operation
- 3) Clear ALL sprinkler heads of debris and overgrown grass for complete water coverage for the entire time you are away. All other sprinkler issues can be reported to management.

IF YOUR UNIT IS NOT PROPERLY MAINTAINED TO THE STANDARDS SET, YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE COST TO ENSURE THAT IT IS

What to bring

ELECTRONICS: Cell phones, computer towers/CPUs, drives (e.g. hard drives, CD drives), laptops, monitors, rechargeable batteries (remove from device, place device in garbage), smart phones, tablets, televisions (must be whole).

CHEMICALS: Automotive fluids, batteries (household or vehicle), cleaners, cooking oil, fertilizers, fluorescent bulbs and other mercury-containing devices, fuels (e.g. gasoline, kerosene), fungicides, herbicides, insecticides, motor oil, paint (latex or oil), paint remover, paint thinner, pesticides, pool chemicals, rechargeable batteries (including vehicle), smoke detectors, solvents, wood preservatives.

What Not to bring

A/C units, alkaline batteries, appliances, biological/infectious waste, camcorders, CD players, copiers, digital cameras, DVD players, empty paint cans, explosives, fax machines, fire extinguishers, garbage, gas cylinders larger than one pound (e.g. propane tanks), GPS units, marine depth finders, medicine, microwave ovens, pagers, portable players, printers, printer/toner cartridges, radioactive waste, radios, stereo equipment, telephones, tires, VCRs, video game players.
