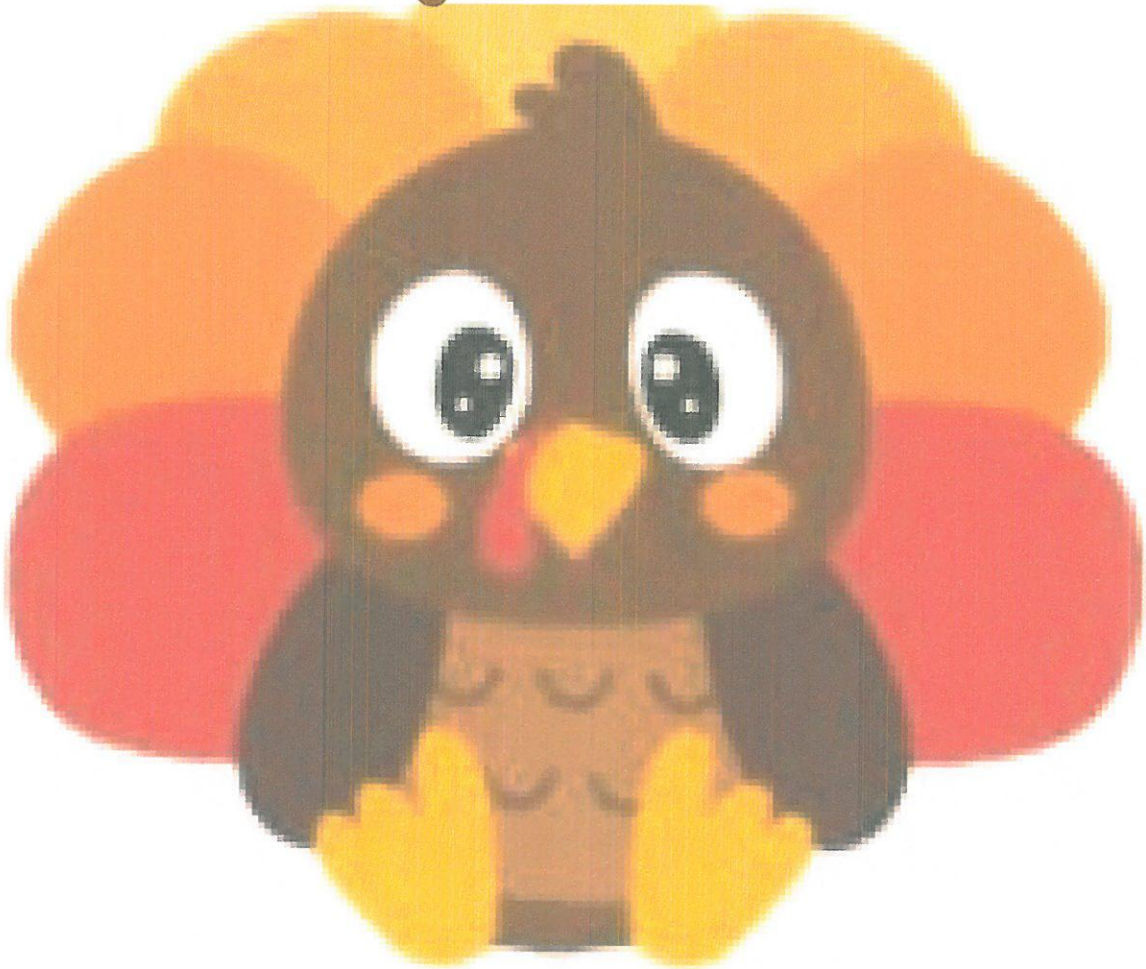

**City Water Line Leaks** – Testing for City water line leaks will start at 9AM Monday November 2 – initially units 80-159 will be without City water for 2-3 hours. If we finish earlier enough, we may test units 16 thru 79. We expect to be completed with all work by 1Pm – please prepare –Sorry for the inconvenience.

**Rules Reminders -General -Pg. 10**

**11.** One "For Sale" sign, not to exceed twelve by fourteen (12" x 14") inches, may be placed on the home ONLY (State Law).

**12.** No other signs or advertising materials will be permitted to be posted on the mobile home or the mobile home space. If you desire, a sign not to exceed four by six (4" x 6") inches advertising a mobile home for sale or giving notices, may be placed on the designated park



bulletin board inside the clubhouse.

**Interpretation by attorney - NO POLITICAL or other SIGNS/FLAGS can be posted or hung on or in someone's property or home that are visible in common areas without Board approval. Political Signs/Flags are not approved by the Board to be displayed**

**Rules Reminders -Mobile Home Sites - pg 15**

4. Residents shall fill out the form titled: "Request to Make Additions or Changes" to mobile home, fixtures or appurtenances for ANY exterior modification, including altering the exterior color, addition or replacement of homes, or any additions, alterations or changes to the Lot. This form will be submitted to the Park Manager who will notify the Board. The Board will then give written approval or denial of the request. All such modifications, additions or replacement must comply with city, county and state codes and standards as established by the Board.

**Interpretation - ANYTHING done outside the home needs a Change form submitted ANYTHING-**

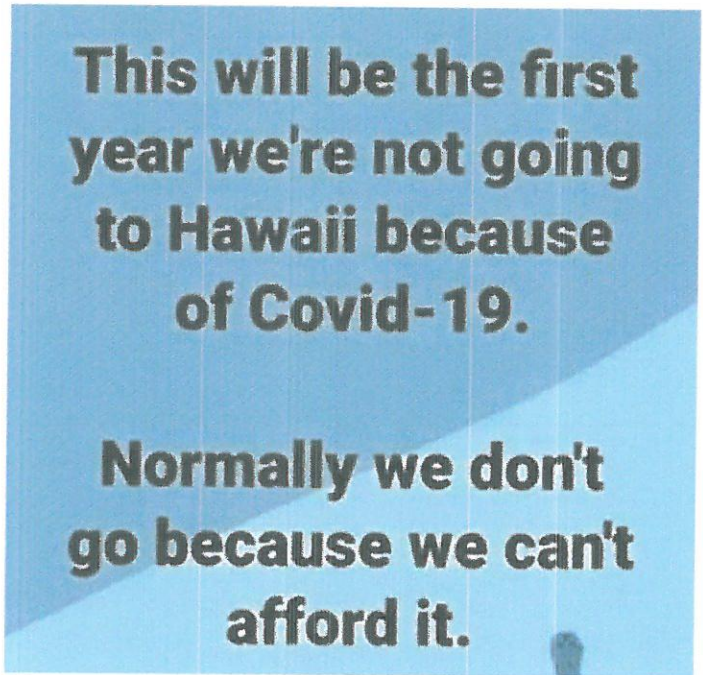
**Example - painting driveway or home - even if same color needs an approved form (simple items like this can immediately be approved)**

REMINDER: it is NOT the responsibility of the Board or Management to know CITY codes or their rules and regulations with regard to your change items. Stonehenge Rules may be stricter than City, so best to get approval first from Stonehedge, then check with City Codes to see if you require a permit on your work.

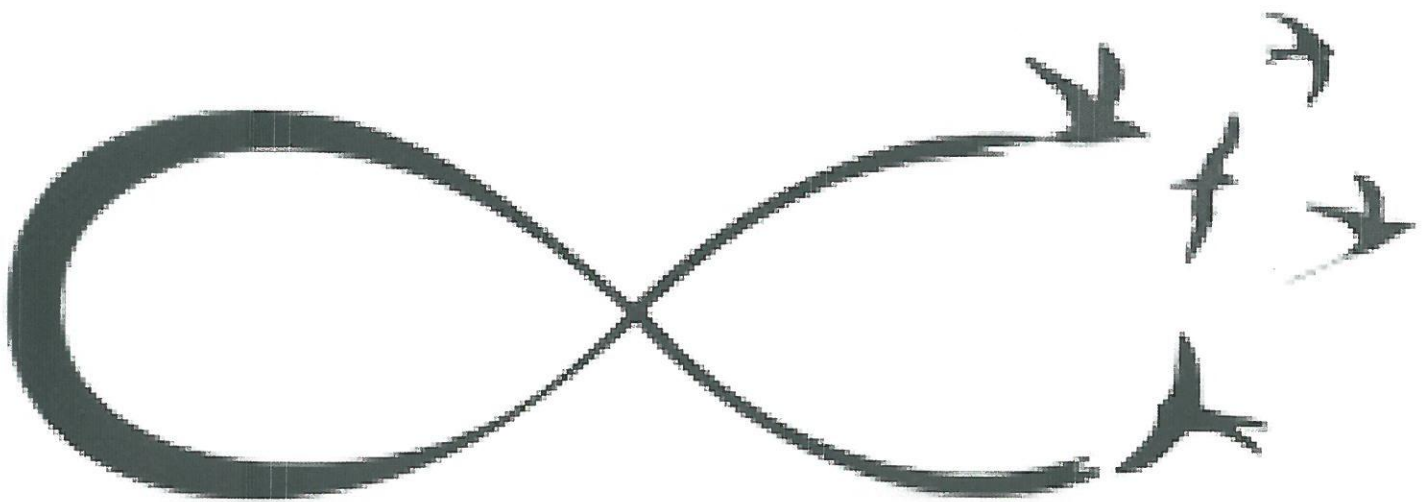

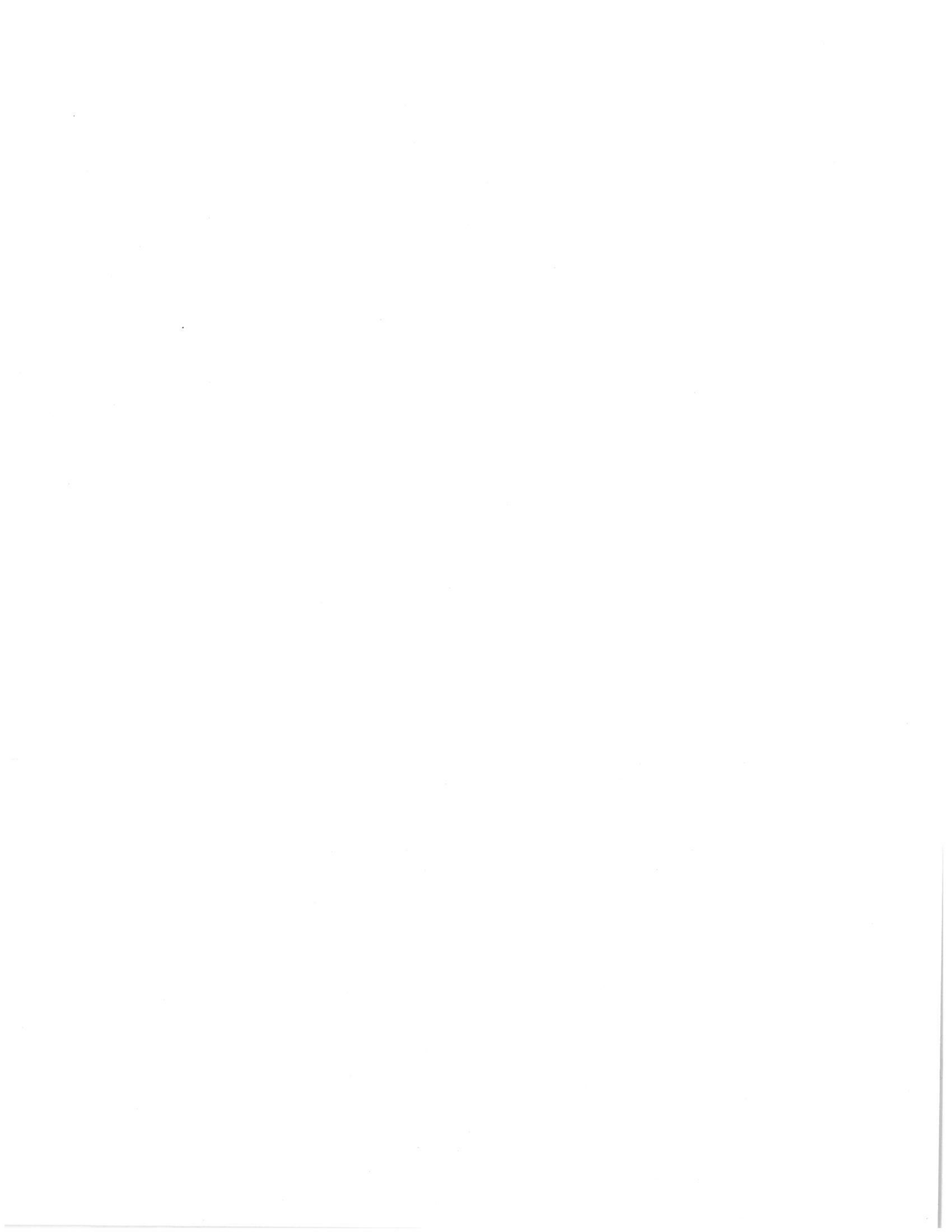

## The Landscape Article

Tis the in between season – we can go either way – not that there is anything wrong with that. The rainy season has left most yards in great shape for the fall season. Yards have come thru so far with very little fungus issues and no chinch bug issues that we are constantly monitoring along with TruGreen -our pest control company as well as Evans Lawn service.

The few yards that have been stressed out have been treated and the visual effects will remain for some time until the healthy grass fills in. This will take some effort on your part to inspect to see if the treatments have worked. Best way to see if the treatments have worked is to mark the affected area with a flag and see if it spreads about 3 days later. Also keep an eye on the affected area(s) because weeds normally sprout up before the healthy grass fills in. This may take some time as we know in Florida weeds grow faster than grass, or at least faster than the weeds they call grass here.

This is where you come in to aid the already in place preventative program. The best way to combat weeds is to clean up that portion of the dead –by raking out the dead portion and putting down a pest control product to aid the already in place controls. This will assure that any remaining pests will be under control when the healthy grass starts to fill in, although we do ask TruGreen to follow up to make sure the activity has been controlled.

Any general lawn pest control product will do, Bayer brand is one of the better ones. If you care to sod after the area has been cleaned up, that is the best time to do this or you can wait for the stronger grass to fill in, either way it's your choice.

November is the start of the season to enjoy seasonal annuals and the cool weather blooming plants.

**NOTE: I cannot stress this enough. When looking for seasonal plantings (Annuals) or even year-round plantings (Perennials) , its best to check out the neighborhood and see what has survived and what looks good. Use the experience that is around you Use the internet, it's the next best source other than your neighborhood. Tarpon Springs is in ZONE 9**

I have direct experience with their garden shops and the knowledge is limited at best. PLEASE DO NOT TAKE THE PLANT LABELS SERIOUS ON THESE GARDEN CENTER PLANTS. If you insist on shopping at these garden centers, I suggest you ask a test question or 2 to see if you get the correct answer, such as “are weed and feeds good to use year round?” The answer is “NO” unless you have a completely spotless lawn that needs no other attention, and I doubt that in Florida. There is a reason these stores are called “do it yourself”

November is also the time you should look at the plants that did not make it thru the hot summer months or those that took extra special care. Unless you have the extra time to fuss with them its best to consider options. This may mean that they are not suited to take the heat and should be changed out. If you care to, replace them with more suitable plants that can take the torrid summer months.

It's also the time to make sure you are prepared for the next years growing season. This can be done by strengthening the lawn you have. A good all-purpose fertilizer for this time is one with a high last number:

To recap – using a good base fertilizer – like an 18-5-10

18- The first number is the nitrogen parts per million for greening

5- is for phosphorous, which is a natural element in the Florida soil, so you do not need to add any at this stage

10- is for potassium (potash) which helps strengthen the root system.

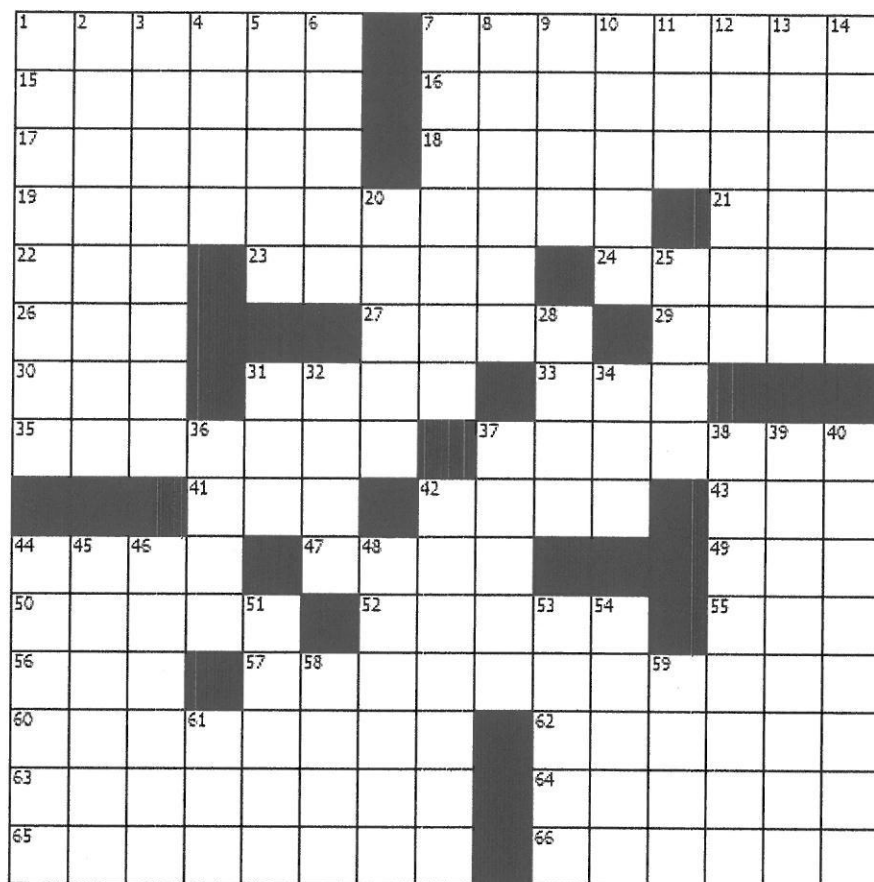
You have the next 2 months to be able to add this to you soil to strengthen it even more than the natural rains did.

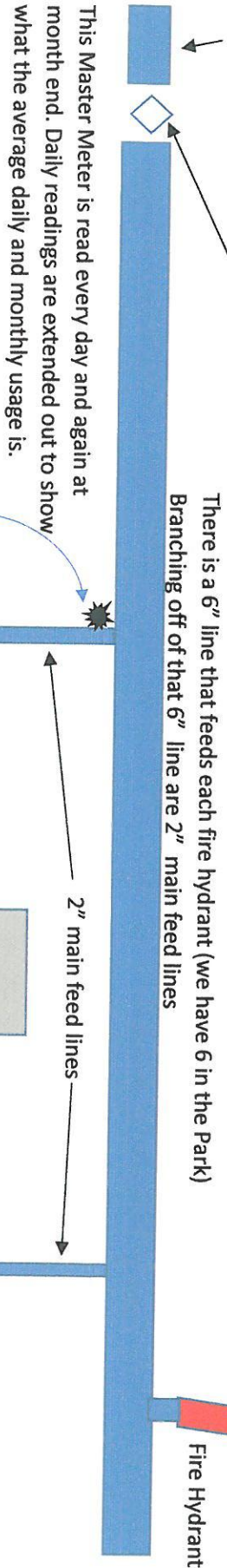

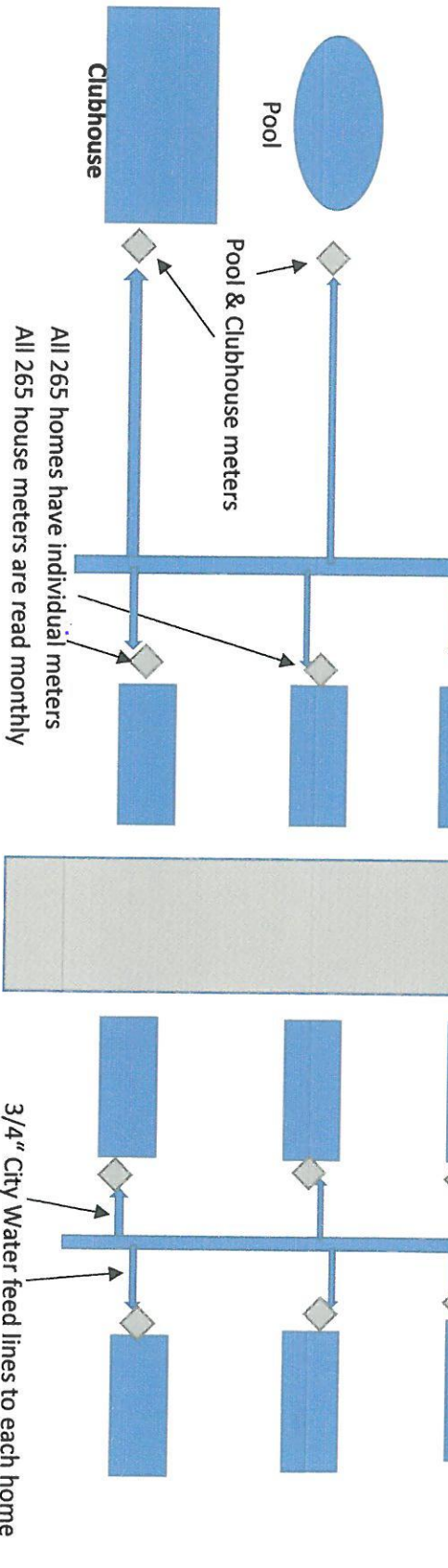


**How we determine the amount of water lost thru leaking City water lines**

Main City water line and Master Meter coming in off US 19



Example of breaks in the City water lines that are read by the Master Meter ONLY  
 NOTE: Stonehedge is billed on the MASTER METER reading. We pay for the water that we never use



- House meters are read at month end to obtain the actual gallons used by every resident. Pool and Clubhouse meters are read to obtain the actual usage for the pool and Clubhouse - these are the only 2 common areas that use City water. NOTE: Irrigation sprinklers systems are Well water
- We subtract the Home and Common area City water month end use total from the Master Meter reading for the month end to determine the difference
- The difference is every gallon of water that does not go thru a meter – the difference is usage from leaks in the system that we pay for but never use
