### Around the Park:

**City Water Line Project:** the survey has been completed on the areas we are looking to attach to

the City 10" line to our North. Now the Engineers will proceed to do our model and drawings to present for bids. Expected to be completed by what was the end of August is now mid to late Sept. due to COVID affecting employees of the company.

**Wells-**Wells are back on for a bit. If we continue to get the 2-3-4+ inches of rain weekly, they will be shut down. Pay attention to the bulletin board announcements. Please be aware of the rainfall and do not run sprinklers if we get more than 1" of in in the week.

**Finally-** the holes created in the clubhouse from the new water lines going in are repaired

**Pressure washing-** we have started to pressure wash the sidewalks around the clubhouse and shuffle courts and will continue with the sidewalks.

**SPECTRUM- The proposal has been accepted by the residents and services will start 9/3. SEE ENCLOSED TV schedule and conversion obligations of the residents for a smooth change**

How Sweet it is or was! Beautiful rains have not only greened and thickened up our lawns, but it has saved our planet over 5 million gallons of well water. A small amount when you come to think about it. The trickle-down effect is less wear and tear on our wells, our valves and our systems in general. So keep on rain dancin'.

We will have to keep an eye on the effects when the dryer conditions come after the recent wet conditions. Your lawns are used to 2-3 inches of rain a week. When being cut to only 1" your lawn may show signs of stress. Usually no worries, grass is very adaptable but it may take a week or 2 to see this. Chinch bugs thrive in the dry conditions and in recent years the past dry spells have caused an invasion of them in our yards. With the new park program, we have managed to come thru the major heat of the summer OK so far with little chinch bug activity. If you keep the weeds at a minimum in those bare areas, the recent rains will allow the runners from the healthy grass to fill in some of those spots. Sorry, but best to hand pull in these areas rather than spray for weeds. The weed killer may inhibit the growth of new grass in those areas as well. Installing a few pieces of sod or plugs will also help that area rejuvenate.

The unusual amount of rains in the recent past month may also cause dormant fungus to thrive. This is easily visible and it takes a quick solution to cure. You will notice a distinct color change in portions of your yard that has been effected by a fungus. Yellowing to a distinct orange ring around the affected areas will show.

IT IS VERY IMPORTANT THAT IN THE FEW WEEKS FOLLOWING THESE HEAVY RAINS TO KEEP A WATCHFUL EYE ON ALL PORTIONS OF YOUR LAWN. FUNGUS CAN START ANYWHERE AND CAN SPREAD EXTREMELY QUICK, IN SOME CASES AFFECTING PORTIONS OF A YARD AT 10-15 SQUARE FEET PER DAY IF NOT MORE

See how much fun Florida gardening is – Dry conditions allow chinch bugs to thrive to destroy your lawn and wet conditions allow fungus to thrive to destroy your lawn.

In coordination with your help the park has also had TruGreen's lawn service do more than one routine inspection of our lawns. We have upped the program to allow for 6 straight blanket sprays of pest control including 2 applications of a chinch bug control for the past 2 years. With an extra set of eyes on our lawns we hope to detect any destructive conditions before they get to far out of hand. A commercial blanket spray for fungus is very costly (and may not be necessary) Most fungus conditions only occur in less than 10% of lawns. A watchful eye is much more cost effective.

A quick homeowner fix to these possible issues is to apply a fungicide to the entire yard. Pay attention to the Park programs that will spray a fungicide on an "as needed" basis. If we do not recognize any issues they will not be sprayed, so it's up to the owners and those watching the yards to assist management to identify any issues. At this time this is the single most "on our mind" issue, so please your cooperation is greatly needed and appreciated.

Once we see how the balance of August and the Start of September leaves us we will put together a schedule for the balance of the year when it comes to fall plantings, lawn, shrub and flowering plant care.

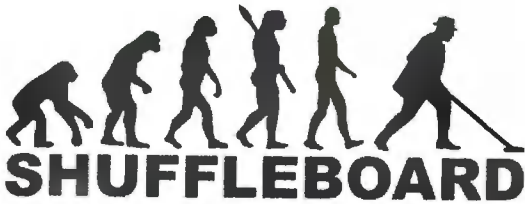

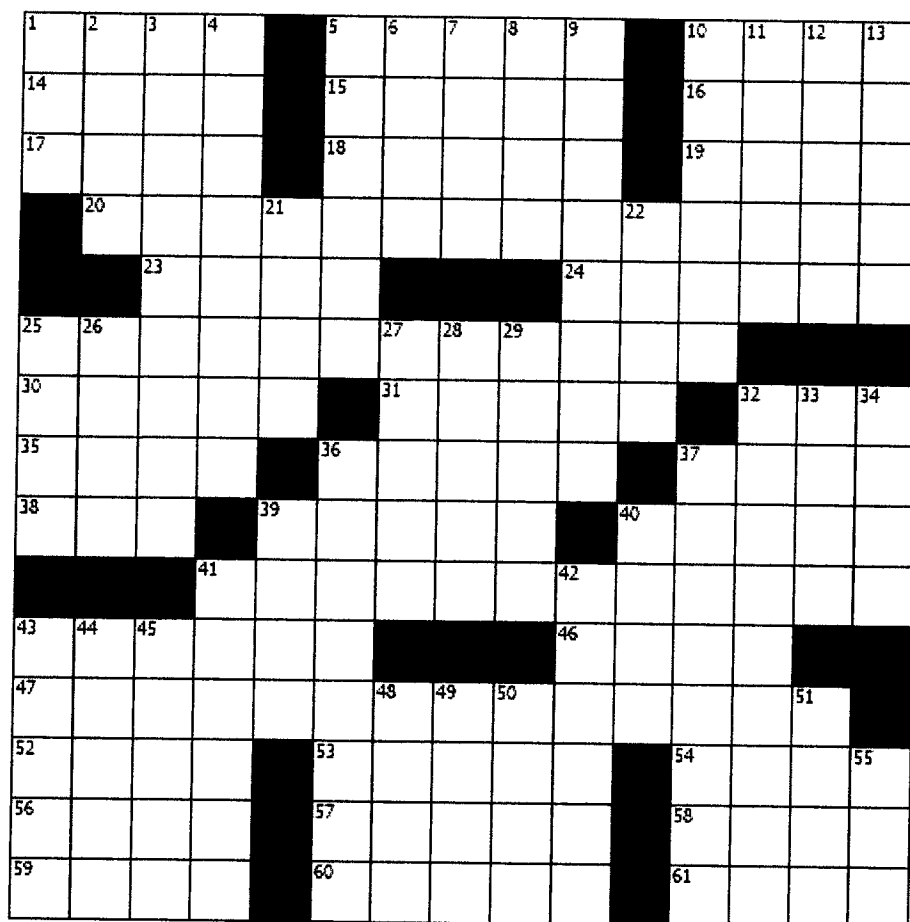

**Residents' participation in the conversion of the New Spectrum contract Services start 9/3/2021 and 1<sup>st</sup> new billing (if you have additional services) will start after 10/2/2021 depending on your current billing cycle**

**Reminder: Your monthly fees will remain at \$265 until the new budget starting Jan 1, 2022, goes into effect**

Currently all residents have Standard Spectrum Cable TV services included in the monthly fees. The changes that will come are the new Cable TV lineup (included), a free 2<sup>nd</sup> non-DVD box and the added Internet. The change in service will start on 9/3/2021 but you will not be receiving an updated Spectrum bill for any additional service you contract for until after 10/2/2021.

**Please read very carefully**

- **For those residents currently with Spectrum Internet plus additional TV channels or a land line phone service:**

**NOTE:** Even though your new service will begin on 9/3 You will still be responsible to pay for any current Spectrum bill you receive until 10/2/2021. After 10/2 your new Spectrum bill should reflect the changes.

**Now pay attention:** depending on your current billing cycle date (which will not change) your Sept. bill may already reflect the discounted new services. You still pay the Sept bill to Spectrum if you get one.

**IMPORTANT:** You will still be on the same billing cycle date after the conversion for any additional services that you will be responsible for:

Example: you will still pay for a third box (since 2 non-DVD boxes are now free) or additional channels not included with the new service. ## BANKING SCAMS

The most common banking scams include:

**OVERPAYMENT SCAMS:** A scam artist sends you a counterfeit check. They tell you to deposit the check in your bank account and wire part of the money back to them. Since the check is fake, you'll have to pay your bank the amount of the check, plus you'll lose any amount of money you wired to the scammer.

**UNSOLICITED CHECK FRAUD:** A scammer sends you a check unsolicited for no reason. If you cash it, you may be authorizing the purchase of items or signing up for a loan that you didn't ask for.

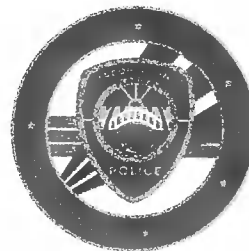
**AUTOMATIC WITHDRAWALS:** A scam company sets up automatic debits from your bank account to qualify for a free trial period or to collect a prize.

**PHISHING:** You receive an unsolicited email message that asks you to verify your bank account, debit card number or personal information.

These scams are very common and sometimes can be difficult to recognize. Never give your personal or financial information to anyone that you did not contact yourself especially over the internet or by phone. Even in-person, be cautious of how much personal information you give out, unless you know for certain it is required and for a legitimate purpose.

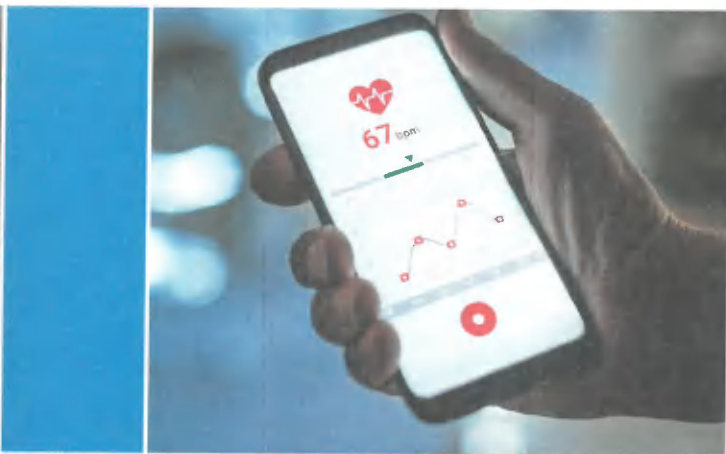

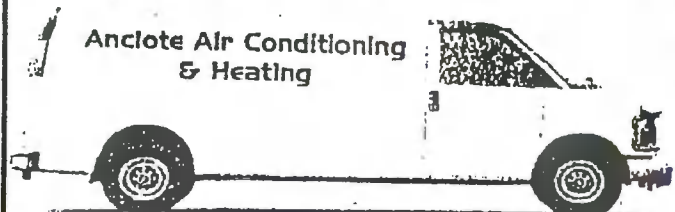

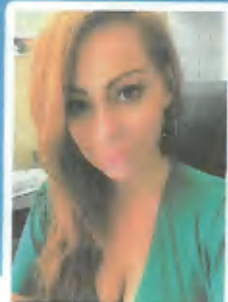
