I appreciate everyone's patience with the road sealing project. We are so close to finishing. There were four days of rain delays that threw our schedule off a bit. Weather permitting, we should be completed by September 5<sup>th</sup> and all barricades down by September 6<sup>th</sup>. There are areas on sidewalks that will be cleaned by our



contractors. <u>Unfortunately, we have had multiple vehicles disregard instructions and ignore the barricades.</u> I must remind everyone not to drive over or around barricades and make sure your guests are aware of any road closing that may affect their visit to our community.

Hey, Lisa. What is going on with the grass? This may be the question I most often hear. There are several issues that we are all trying to combat. We had a very long dry spell accompanied by day after day of extreme heat warnings. Even with following proper watering regulations, many areas experienced some browning and crunchy turf. This was followed by a spell of excessive rain, combined with regular irrigation, which causes several types of fungus and more yellowing. Also, St. Augustine turf is susceptible to chinch bugs and white grubs which appears annually. A healthy lawn requires one inch of rain per week. Over the last ten days, we have received five and a half inches of rain. Our wells have been shut down to prevent over-watering, which promotes the previously mentioned issues. The wells will be turned back on once we have a lower weekly rainfall totals. Our landscapers are mowing at the recommended height for St. Augustine, and our pest control company is treating for pests and fungus. All we can do is continue with the recommendations and attempt to fight mother nature. Praying to the Gods of rain could never hurt either.
