

Manager's Korner

Get ready, peace and quiet, well at least more peace and guiet, with over 50% of our residents leaving to visit their northern home away from home, we are in that slower down mode. With less activity and parties to attend this is a perfect time to get all those little projects out of the way. But no need to rush into anything. Take some time to enjoy the peace and quiet for a bit before you dig into any projects. Speaking about peace and quiet, Shannon and his wife Nikki have sent some pictures of the beautiful piece of Kentucky property they are living on - with no other houses in sight. He has taken videos and pictures of the beautiful Kentucky mountain roads with no other cars in sight. The true test of serenity will come if he can take pictures of Wal-Mart - with no aliens in sight. Haha just kidding Wal-Mart shoppers.

We do have a new maintenance man(Scott). He started Wednesday 4/18, unfortunately Shannon's last day was 4/13 so he will have to learn quickly and pick up what I know about the property. He has some household experience with plumbing and electrical as well as home sprinkler issues and some pool experience. Transferring that knowledge to 34 acres and getting in to commercial wells and pools is a bit of a change, but hopefully the basics can be incorporated. The initial feeling is that he is enthusiastic enough to learn and manage it on his own with a few months training. Then again, he is from MA. and a Red Sox, Bruins and Patriots fan, I just hope he doesn't hide in the closet when they are losing. hahaha

Updates on the park projects;

Road Seal – we will seal coat the roads with a 2 coat Gem Seal polytar – an excellent product according to the experts. I recently took a 2-hour class on road maintenance and this product was highly recommended

Roof replacement for mailroom and garage – received our 3 bids and will shingle the garage roof and use a metal roof on the main room. Reason

being the mailroom is more visible and having a metal roof (color to be determined) will be more aesthetically pleasing as well as more durable than the shingle roof Clubhouse time cleaning and grout seal - 3 bids were \$3600, \$4500 and \$5800 to clean and reseal the grout lines. I think at these prices the Board decided to use a little staff elbow grease and cut our costs by doing this in house with some rented equipment. Works for me - we will try that approach this summer Pool Gas heater- is down- the heat exchanger rotted out- we still heat the pool to temp with 2 heat pumps that are highly sufficient and able to keep up with our current outdoor temperatures. We see no reason to purchase one now -only to have chlorinated water running thru it (no way to bypass) and it not being operational. We will look to replace (\$3600) In Sept-Oct when it is needed. Stumps- we have identified and had reported 24 so far. We have called the company to remove them and waiting on their schedule. Clubhouse Generator- we are going to pick up this conversation again with our electrician and explore costs

As mentioned with over 50% of our residents leaving, we have less eyes to keep in touch with what is happening around the property. This is very important since we are the only line of defense against scam artists that come into our property. Believe me they will be around and knocking. Please just a friendly "no thank you" will do and immediately report it to the office. Try to get the color and make of the vehicle and a plate # if possible - but in no way engage in conversation. We will take care of that. With regard to those who know on doors as well as those who call you on the phone IF YOU HAVE NOT REQUESTED INFORMATION OR A SERVICE, I DO NOT CARE HOW CONVINCING THEY SOUND. DO NOT TALK TO THEM!!! **RECORDS AND KEY CHECK** – Please make time to stop into the office to check your emergency contacts and to make sure we have current keys on file just in case of an emergency while you are gone

WHEN CAN I MOW MY GRASS AFTER A HERBICIDE OR WEED CONTROL APPLICATION?

Short Answer: Wait until tomorrow before you mow your grass if a weed control application was made today. Not 24 hours, just overnight.

Mini tip: Rain does not negatively affect an herbicide application. Once our material has been on the leaf for 15 to 20 minutes it is absorbed into the first few layers of the leaf & will not be washed out.

Explanation: During the night weeds move the herbicides throughout their system. It is during darkness that all plants move or translocate materials throughout their phloem. Think of it as a nighttime transportation system that moves sugars, amino acids... and herbicides throughout the plant under the dark of night. There is some movement & activity during the daylight hours, but not nearly as much as at night.

Note: you do not have to wait 24 hours before mowing. Just one period of darkness is sufficient. For example, if a Manor is applied at 4 pm, you can mow the next day at 8 am (or as early as your neighbors allow). However, if the same herbicide is applied at 8 am, you should wait until the following day to mow your grass to get the full effectiveness of the herbicide.

Finally, ask any of your ATA attendees about the 4 parts of any weed control application: 1) contact, 2) absorption, 3) translocation, and 4) disruption of some normal plant function. Where does mowing fit into this scenario?
