Manager's Korner

September 2018

"Watch out baby, for here I come" sounds like the start of a good tune, but it's the call of the snowbirds returning to the winter nest at Stonehedge. We look forward to the return of a bunch of fun loving residents. Sure, we all enjoy the peace and quiet, but we also love the buzz. I said buzz, not bull haha. As always there have been some changes – new residents – some park upgrades and some park items (and residents) getting a bit older. We look forward to another enjoyable season here at this wonderful park that you have all contributed to create.

I do not need to remind everyone to be safe on the road. If there is an idiot out there – let him be – proving a point that someone is an idiot on the road will not change that idiot into a genius. Enjoy your ride and let him or her find their grave someplace else.

IMPORTANT NOTE ABOUT THE DIGITAL CONVERSION OF OUR PARK'S TELEVISION SERVICE:

I have been in contact with our representative for our conversion.

- Digital conversion Transition DATE: October 9, 2018
- Each resident will receive a letter from Spectrum 1 MONTH prior to the transition date to explain your options—so expect yours this first week of Sept
- 3. You can call in to get the new box shipped to your home or you can bring in your old box

- You get 1 box FREE, if you do not have a box you still get 1 for FREE
- 5. A TV WILL NOT GET RECEPTION IF YOU DO NOT HAVE A BOX- not even SMART TV,s -so if you have 3 TV's you will get one box free and have to pay for 2 boxes if you want the other TV's to work

NOTE: about this -I have been told that Samsung smart TV's will accept the signal from Spectrum but only if hooked up directly to the internet – you will get all stations via streaming – but this is for the tech savvy and I cannot explain further – Spectrum tech dept can help if you call them.

- 6. Each additional box is \$5.99 per month Who does not need a new box:
- If you have an upgraded service like a DVR service from Spectrum – you do not need to change the box- if you are not sure <u>CALL SPECTRUM NOW</u> and save time when everyone is trying to change
- 8. SPECTRUM WILL NOT SEND OUT A REP TO DISCUSS THE CONVERSION
- 9. IF YOU HAVE QUESTIONS AFTER YOU RECEIVE THE LETTER FROM SPECTRUM (sometime in Sept)- COME TO THE OFFICE AND I WILL TRY TO HELP YOU WITH THE CONVERSION

Clubhouse Generator- Had a rep from Generac come out to review our situation -WOW – to hook up a generator to keep us going during a storm shutdown is in the \$40,000 range with all the electrical and gas hookups, as well as, the generator cost – based on that, it seems like the cost effectiveness is not there since the clubhouse has not lost power in many, many years (25+) from what I hear.

ALSO: we had Duke inspect our electrical situation here at the park and we are better off than most. We have 2 independent feeds

supplying our power which is why during the last hurricane only ½ the park lost power. We are supplied from 2 separate stations – one coming in off of US 19 and one off of Mango St. At this point there is no desperate need for the expense.

Lawns- as you may have noticed many of the died-out lawns are coming back very healthy. There is still a bit of work to be done, but all should be fine if we continue to have the help of Mother Nature. There is no need to rake up the dead grass – it will act as a cover from the sun and new grass will fill in.

<u>Coyote Caution</u>: Slight bit of caution - it has never been an issue and we do not see it being one in the future but...

There have been coyote's sighted at and around the retention pond here at Stonehedge. I have seen them and its been reported that as many as 10 to 12 in all sizes – including pups - have been sighted.

Making noise, clapping hands have scared them off. If they are with pups avoid aggressive behavior

There is a large area with plenty of food located just behind our West fence line, as well as 3 acres of Habitat for Humanity property that is completely overgrown to the East behind units 50-54. That is most likely where their shelter is. Since they are a non-invasive a species and non-aggressive towards humans according to Animal control, even some trappers will not trap them.

<u>CAUTION:</u> They need to eat, and if they do not find enough food in their area of nesting, they will attack unattended DOGS AND CATS.
