





How Sweet it is or was! Beautiful rains have not only greened and thickened up our lawns, but it has saved our planet over 1.5 million gallons of well water. A small amount when you come to think about it. The trickledown effect is less wear and tear on our wells, our valves and our systems in general. So keep on rain dancin'.

We will have to keep an eye on the effects when the dryer conditions come after the recent wet conditions. Your lawns are used to 2-3 inches of rain a week. When being cut to only 1" your lawn may show signs of stress. Usually no worries, grass is very adaptable but it may take a week or 2 to see this. Chinch bugs thrive in the dry conditions and in recent years the past dry spells have caused an invasion of them in our yards. With the new park program, we have managed to come thru the major heat of the summer OK so far with little chinch bug activity. If you keep the weeds at a minimum in those bare areas, the recent rains will allow the runners from the healthy grass to fill in some of those spots. Sorry, but best to hand pull in these areas rather than spray for weeds. The weed killer may inhibit the growth of new grass in those areas as well. Installing a few pieces of sod or plugs will also help that area rejuvenate.

The unusual amount of rains in the recent past may also cause dormant fungus to thrive. This is easily visible and it take a quick solution to cure. You will notice a distinct color changes in portions of your yard that has been effected by a fungus. Yellowing to a distinct orange ring around the affected areas will show.

IT IS VERY IMPORTANT THAT IN THE FEW WEEKS FOLLOWING THESE HEAVY RAINS TO KEEP A WATCHFUL EYE ON ALL PORTIONS OF YOUR LAWN. FUNGUS CAN START ANYWHERE AND CAN SPREAD EXTREMELY QUICK, IN SOME CASES AFFECTING PORTIONS OF A YARD AT 10-15 SQUARE FEET PER DAY IF NOT MORE

See how much fun Florida gardening is – Dry conditions allow chinch bugs to thrive to destroy your lawn and wet conditions allow fungus to thrive to destroy your lawn.

In coordination with your help the park has also had TruGreen's lawn service do more than one routine inspection of our lawns. We have upped the program to allow for 6 straight blanket sprays of pest control including 2 applications of a chinch bug control. With an extra set of eyes on our lawns we hope to detect any destructive conditions before they get to far out of hand. A commercial blanket spray for fungus is very costly (and may not be necessary) Most fungus conditions only occur in less than 10% of lawns. A watchful eye is much more cost effective.

A quick homeowner fix to these possible issues it to apply a fungicide to the entire yard. Pay attention to the Park programs that will spray a fungicide on an "as needed" basis. If we do not recognize any issues they will not be sprayed, so it's up to the owners and those watching the yards to assist management to identify any issues. At this time this is the single most "on our mind" issue, so please your cooperation is greatly needed and appreciated.

Once we see how the balance of August and the Start of September leaves us we will put together a schedule for the balance of the year when it comes to fall plantings, lawn, shrub and flowering plant care.
