I know it seems like it came fast this year. We are not far from Christmas or the New Year, I know we have all been thru plenty of them and it seems to change every year. Some have new grandkids- maybe even great grandkids - some kids getting married - some for the 2nd time or more. Some unfortunately have lost a partner or other family member. Its all part of change and a wonderful time to remember the new that has come into our lives and for those who no longer are here that have given so much of their life to make us happy. No matter what you think about where we go or what happens to our spirit, I have to believe they are there watching over us and we are here to watch over the new ones that have come into this world when we are gone.

I have a story – about my sister-in law who recently passed away - not really a Christmas story but one that has shown me again that we all have a spirit that lives on and should be celebrated.

My wife and family grew up in MA. She had 3 sisters who had a few kids each. One, the oldest sister, Judy, had a son who was a bit of trouble early in life and it continued. Over the years no less than 5 grandkids have surfaced on her sister Judy's doorstep saying – Hi Grandma. All from this troubled son's relations with various women. Judy and husband Fred accepted all of them with open arms. Paying their way and making sure they all had a beautiful Christmas as a family. Her son, the father, was and still is nowhere to be found but does call from time to time – giving no details of whereabouts.

Back in the 80's this troubled son was into drugs and always was with a seedy crowd. As the story goes, back in 1982, a teenage girl – apparently into drugs – disappeared from a party in a neighboring MA town and was never found-last seen at 2AM leaving the party with some men of which Judy's troubled son was one of them. The story was told In the papers that the missing girl was in debt to the local drug dealers. The police questioned Judy's troubled son since he was at the party and they knew he was known to hang out with the dealers. He was a suspect for some time, but no one was ever charged since nothing was found – no girl – her car – nothing.

Well, my wife's sister Judy, who was very sick-unfortunately passed away on Wednesday, 11/3 at 4AM. The local MA papers that same Wednesday morning 11/3 just hours after Judy passed reported that the police - based on an anonymous tip - had dredged a river that ran thru some desolate wooded area in the neighborhood and found and identified the missing girl's car from 1982 – missing for 39 years. Around the Park:

<u>Storm Drain line scope –</u> The camera viewing is done, and we have met to review any issues – there are issues that need to be addressed – the Board will discuss during meetings and keep the residents informed

<u>Pressure washing-</u> the sidewalks have been started – thank you to the volunteers.

<u>Palm Trees</u> – the order is in for those who requested, and they should be installed shortly by Evans Lawn service.

<u>Stage expansion</u> - The clubhouse stage has been expanded 7 or so feet wider – this also was done by volunteers: Thank you to Darrell Streff and Dave Schuyler.

<u>Wells</u> - Please make sure your sprinkler timers are correctly set.

Electronic Water meters - we have consistently had issues with not only water leaks in the main lines but also in the homes – recently nearly 200,000 gallons in the past few months. These leaks are attributed to leaking toilets, breaks under the home or at the meter itself. It has cost the associations nearly \$4,000. We have investigated electronic water meters for each home that will detect these leaks immediately instead of waiting till months end when we read meters to find out there is an issue.

<u>Budget for 2022</u> – The meeting on November 10th approved the new Budget maintenance fees for 2022 of \$285 of which \$15 of the increase was attributed to adding internet services.

REMINDER: if you signed up for auto pay directly with **BB & T** your fees withdraw will automatically be changed.

BUT if you signed up directly with your bank, **YOU MUST** let them know the fees have increased.



HOW COLD IS IT?

In the heyday of sailing ships, all war ships and many freighters carried iron cannons. Those cannons fired round iron cannon balls. It was necessary to keep a good supply near the cannon. However, how to prevent them from rolling about the deck? The best storage method devised was a square-based pyramid with one ball on top, resting on four resting on nine, which rested on sixteen. Thus, a supply of 30 cannon balls could be stacked in a small area right next to the cannon.

There was only one problem....how to prevent the bottom layer from sliding or rolling from under the others. The solution was a metal plate called a 'Monkey' with 16 round indentations. However, if this plate were made of iron, the iron balls would quickly rust to it. The solution to the rusting problem was to make 'Brass Monkeys.' Few landlubbers realize that brass contracts much more and much faster than iron. when chilled.. Consequently, when the temperature dropped too far, the brass indentations would shrink so much that the iron cannonballs would come right off the monkey; Thus, it was quite literally, 'Cold enough to freeze the balls off a brass monkey.'
