Good Day to ali. Many good things have been going on despite the same ole' COVID stuff. Travei has recently increased and hopefully many will be returning to Stonehedge. Even though we have some nice projects in the works, many projects have been delayed, due to lack of help in the various fields we deal with. Some services may have also been affected. This is what we have all dealt with, fact or fiction. As always, I encourage residents to attend Board and /or Committee meetings. So much park information is discussed, and many residents have knowledge of related projects that their input can be utilized.

Budget: The proposed budget will be mailed to every resident around October 10 and the 2022 Budget approval meeting will be held November 10. Make plans to attend.

Around the Park:

<u>City Water Line Project:</u> Drawings expected to be completed shortly. We had a meeting with the 3 engineers on Engineer and they are finalizing our plan.

Wells -Wells are back on. Please make sure your timers are correctly set. The first week alone we have sprinklers running on the weekend and some on consecutive days. This is not proper use of the well water.

NOTE: We have 2 wells down (dry) and issues with 3 others. We will be exploring locations to add at least 2 wells to get more pressure to the current system. Do your part in conserving our wells. Thank you

Landscape We have a front entrance landscape project in the works to remove and spruce up the old bushes there as well as combining that with the back entrance upgrade.

<u>Pool Chaise lounges</u>- the re-strapped pool lounges are expected back early October

<u>Pressure washing-</u> we have started to pressure wash the pool area and will continue with sidewalks after that.

Spectrum- The conversion is done. Residents should not be seeing charges for the first 2 boxes (if they are non-recordable) and no charge for Internet service. If your internet is slow, it may be because you have an old modem. Some of the older modems only handle slower speeds (we get 400MB). You may have to change it out or call Spectrum to change it for you

This message goes out to a select few but still needs to be mentioned. I really hate to harp on this, but I have to but since there is and has been less travel in the past few years there are some homes that could use some additional attention. More time home is more time to take care of what needs to be done around the home here at Stonehedge. I am not sure how much longer I will be here - since I am getting older than retirement age. I can tell you (or promise you) that the next guy will not be as lenient. understanding, and tolerant as I have been. I have given residents the benefit of the doubt, to my own fault. I will not leave some of the homes here at Stonehedge in the shape they are in and will make sure under the power of your rules to correct the home issues that need to be corrected. Some of the issues are so small that its surprising that they have not been cleaned up, but yet add to the total mess. Some old block piled up, ladders out that can be stored in our garage area, trash cans, recycle bins left out, piled up lawn chairs not in use, stuff stacked behind homes that is seen every month by the meter readers, by those who walk, during regular inspections. Some stuff you don't even have to look for, the mess is right in front of you, yet it remains. These are not my rules - but yours. I am sure if I did not do my job for you, I would be reminded of it (and have been), so I am reminding you of yours. The only difference I see is that I work to correct mine.

<u>Snowbird/Travel Form</u> As a reminder – since many are missing this form with the info on who is watching your place - anytime you leave for 2 weeks or longer we need to have this form on file.

Rule Reminder - under RESIDENT RESPONSI-BILITIES pg 21 #1:

1 Any unit owner absent from the Park exceeding two weeks is required to complete a Snowbird Fly-Away form. Forms available on line and in the office REMINDER: Since this is a rule failure to turn one in may result in a fine.

The Landscape Article

Tis the in between season – we can go either way – not that there is anything wrong with that. The rainy season has left most yards in great shape for the fall season. Yards have come thru so far with very littie fungus issues and some minor chinch bug issues that we are constantly monitoring along with TruGreen our pest control company as well as Evans Lawn service.

Now, about going either way, we can get the regular rains weekly or none at all. That is for Mother Nature to decide and for you to check out the results and adjust your programs to.

The few yards that have been affected with fungus or chinch bugs have been treated and the visual effects will remain for some time until the healthy grass fills in. This will take some effort on your part to inspect to see if the treatments have worked. Best way to see if the treatments have worked is to mark the affected area with a flag and see if it spreads about 3 days later. Also keep an eye on the affected area(s) because weeds normally sprout up before the healthy grass fills in. This may take some time as we know in Florida weeds grow faster than grass, or at least faster than the weeds they call grass here.

This is where you come in to aid the already in place park preventative program. The best way to combat weeds is to clean up that portion of the dead —by raking out the dead portion and putting down a pest control product to aid the already in place controls. This will assure that any remaining pests will be under control when the healthy grass starts to fill in, although we do ask TruGreen to follow up to make sure the activity has been controlled.

Any general lawn pest control product will do, Bayer brand is one of the better ones. If you care to sod after the area has been cleaned up, that is the best time to do this or you can wait for the stronger grass to fill in, either way it's your choice.

Another way to combat reoccurring weeds that find their way in between your healthy lawn or grow in those bare spots is to please use a separate weed killer — weed and feed combination fertilizer and weed killers are only recommended in the colder months (Dec, Jan, Feb), I don't recommend them at all. Reason is that cooler months tend to kill out weeds faster and do not need much additional help. Best to put as little product into the environment as possible.

NOTE: I cannot stress this enough. When looking for seasonal plantings (Annuals) or even year-round plantings (Perennials), its best to check out the neighborhood and see what has survived and what looks good. Use the experience that is around you Use the internet, it's the next best source other than your neighborhood. Tarpon Springs is in ZONE 9

I have direct experience with their garden shops and the knowledge is limited at best. PLEASE DO NOT TAKE THE PLANT LABELS SERIOUS ON THESE GARDEN CENTER PLANTS. There is a reason these stores are called "do it yourself". They should be called "Learn it yourself" centers

October is also the time you should look at the plants that did not make it thru the hot summer months or those that took extra special care. Unless you have the extra time to fuss with them its best to consider options. This may mean that they are not suited to take the heat and should be changed out. If you care to, replace them with more suitable plants that can take the torrid summer months.

It's also the time to make sure you are prepared for the next years growing season. This can be done by strengthening the lawn you have. A good all-purpose fertilizer for this time is one with a high-end number:

To recap fertilizers from previous articles: (the following have been detailed much further in previous articles) Using an example of a good fertilizer labeled as a 18-5-10

18- The first number is the nitrogen parts per million for greening

5- is for phosphorous, which is a natural element in the Florida soil, so you do not need to add any at this stage

10- is for potassium (potash) which helps strengthen the root system.

You have the next 2 months to be able to add this to you soil to strengthen it even more than the natural rains did.

Over the next 2-3 months we will be discussing the do's and don'ts of fall and winter gardening. The current Don't is – DO NOT OVERWATER is we get cooler weather (80's in the day, 70's night)

See you next month --It's a good day on the green side of the grass

HELLO STONEHEDGE SHUFFLERS AND RESIDENTS,

The Stonehedge Shuffleboard League will be having their annual fall meeting on **Tuesday October 12, 2021, 1:00 p.m.** at the clubhouse.
(NOTE: The date is the same as previously announced but the time has been changed to **1:00 P.M.**)

We will be voting on one open position on the board and other agenda items which will be posted in the clubhouse two weeks prior the meeting.
