We toured the following four national parks: Sequoia, Kings Canyon, Yosemite and Death Valley. Yosemite was a pleasant surprise. The valley is so beautiful, the waterfalls breathtaking and the Sierra Nevada range is awesome. Yosemite is the Mecca of rock climbing, with El Capitan and Half Dome.
