FROM THE FRONT OFFICE

- * Storm drains have been relined, with only minor touch-up left to do, specifically with building up manhole access.
- * The lift station behind #192 has developed a major problem which is being dealt with temporarily, with a complete rebuild to bring it up to code scheduled as soon as repair parts arrive (in about 3-4 weeks).
- * A project to repair leaking fire hydrants has been postponed, since they only leak when opened, and repairs are expensive (around \$6K per hydrant).
- * A new bicycle rack, which will hold 8 bikes, has been installed in back of the pool.
- * Please, if you turn off or adjust the radio and/or amplifiers in the craft room, make a note as to what adjustments you made and return settings to where you found them when your function is over: it's very frustrating for the next person, who must try to figure out how to put it back to the way it was. Also, if you wish to use the clubhouse TVs and DVD player or to hook up any other device and you're not sure how, please ask someone who knows how.
- * With regard to watering lawns here in the park: Pinellas County currently mandates limiting the watering of lawns to once a week. Thanks in advance for your compliance.

MEET THE NEW BOSS

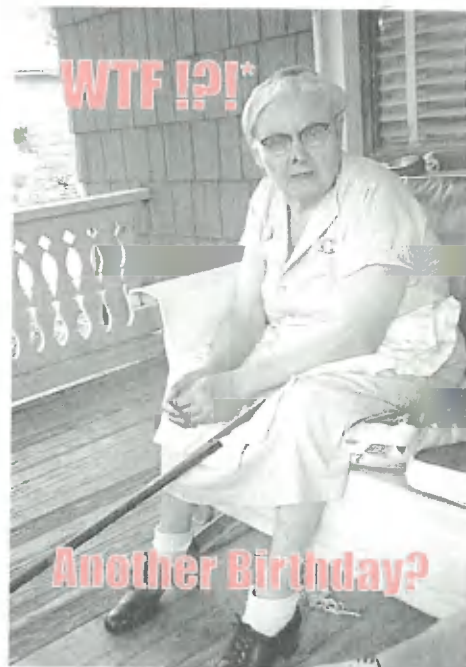
