MANAGER'S KORNER

Florida autumn has arrived. It's time to pull out the sweaters, fluffy blankets and grab a steaming cup of your favorite beverage. Hurricane season has ended, and precipitation totals will drop, making for the wonderful Florida winters we all love. It's also time for our turf areas to take their winter nap, which makes it a great time to make sure your irrigation system is working properly.

City of Tarpon Springs Watering Restrictions

Following are the requirements in effect until further notice:

Irrigation Using City Water or Irrigation Using Wells/Lakes/Ponds

Irrigation of established lawns and landscaping is authorized for **one day per week**.

If your house number ends in:	Then you may water on:
0 or 1	Monday
2 or 3	Tuesday
4 or 5	Wednesday
6 or 7	Thursday
8 or 9	Friday
Mixed or No address	Friday

Watering is limited to **the following hours** to minimize evaporative losses:

Morning Hours
12:01 AM to 8:00 AM

OR

Evening Hours
6:00 PM to 11:59 PM

Watering is prohibited between the hours of 8:00 AM and 6:00 PM.

Maintenance Responsibilities

Resident's and/or Caretakers need to run through the system checking timers making sure they are set to the above schedule, as well as checking heads and filters to ensure proper flow. Clean around irrigation donuts and install around heads without donuts.

Only SRI Maintenance Staff are authorized to make repairs to diaphragms, valves, solenoids and main lines. Please submit a Work Order available on the table outside the office door or email the office for a printable form.

PLEASE USE CAUTION

Residents are returning for the season and guests will be visiting for the holidays. All modes of transportation need to use caution at stop signs, coming to a complete stop and following right of way procedures. Pedestrians always have the right of way. For the safety of residents, guests, staff and contractors, please adhere to the park speed limit of 15 mph.
