In this edition, the new Spectrum Bulk Contract and what it means for our community.

#### **Contract Activation and Billing Dates**

The new Spectrum Bulk Contract will be activated on 12/26/2025. For Stonehedge residents, the effective billing date will be 1/25/2026.

#### **Upgrade Details for Current Spectrum Users**

If you are already a Spectrum customer, no action is required to receive the upgrade. The transition will occur automatically, ensuring a seamless experience for all current users.

#### TV Service Upgrade

Each unit will be upgraded from Spectrum TV Select Signature to Spectrum TV Select Plus. This enhanced package includes all features from the previous plan and adds several new channels: MLB Network, NBA TV, NFL Network, NHL Network, and Tennis Channel.

In addition, you will continue to have access to the streaming apps currently available in your plan, including Disney+ Ad Supported, Hulu Ad Supported, ESPN Unlimited, HBO Max Basic with Ads, Peacock Premium with Ads, Paramount+ Essential, FOX One, AMC+ with Ads, ViX Premium with Ads, and the Tennis Channel.

#### **Internet Service Upgrade**

The Internet connection will be upgraded to Spectrum Internet Advanced Community WIFI Ultra. This upgrade will increase download speeds from 400 Mbps to 600 Mbps, while upload speeds will remain at 20 Mbps. These improvements will result in faster streaming, reduced latency, and support for more connected devices.

#### **Equipment Provided**

The new services include the following equipment: two Xumo Boxes or two top set boxes, one modem, and one router. If you are currently on the Spectrum Bulk agreement, you should already possess this equipment and do not need to add any more.

#### Don't be a Drip - Check for water leaks



Approximately 80 water meter sending units were recently replaced, allowing management to view continuous and excessive flow for each home in our community. What I am now able to see is that we have quite a few homes with slow leaks. In the process of notifying owners, I am finding that the most common leaks are toilets that keep refilling. The average continuous flow is 13 gallons per hour/312 gallons per day. We currently have 17 units on our continuous flow list. This means that we have approximately 5,000 gallons per day literally going down the drain.

Please, check your faucets and your toilets, even in unused bathrooms, for possible leaks.

A volunteer sign-up sheet has been posted on the bulletin board for anyone who would like to **pressure wash sidewalks** for you and/or a section of your street. Everything will be set up for your use and instructions will be given on how to operate.

Tenants, please be aware that a hose could be connected to your irrigation pipe to supply water to the pressure washer.



We are currently in the testing stage of the Stonehedge owner portal, known as Cinc. #### Solid Waste, Recycling & Yard Waste Schedule

There will be **No Solid Waste Collection** for <u>Yard Waste or Recycling</u> on **Christmas Day or New Year's Day.** Regular collection will resume the following regular collection day. There will be **no Friday pick up** for the lost Thursday. <u>Please store appropriately for the next scheduled pick up</u>.

#### **2026 Monthly Maintenance Fees**

Stonehedge Board of Directors has approved the 2026 Budget. The **monthly maintenance fee** will increase to **\$380.00 beginning January 1**<sup>st</sup>. If you are currently set up to have your monthly fees pulled directly from your account on the 3<sup>rd</sup> of each month (ACH), you will not need to do anything as it is automatically changed. If you have instructed your bank to send payment monthly (Bill Pay), you will need to contact your bank to make the necessary changes. If you pay by check or money order, you will receive your 2026 coupon book directly from the SRI bank. If you are not sure how you have been paying, please contact the office for assistance

#### **Larger Than Cans Aluminum Recycling**

Over time, maintenance has collected up pieces of aluminum and has stored them in the garage area. Old ladders, gutters and downspouts, awnings and who knows what else is under the pile. This **Wednesday**, **Dec.** 3<sup>rd</sup>, we will be renting a trailer and taking to be recycled. If you have pieces of aluminum lying around and would like it hauled away, feel free to bring them up to the garage for disposal, **no later than 8am Wednesday**. If you would like to help load the trailer, please contact the office or maintenance. All proceeds pay for the trailer rental (approximately \$25) and the remainer will be used for the purchase of an ice machine for the clubhouse.


