<u>Time flies!</u> It's hard to believe that it's already October. To those arriving, Welcome Back! To those holding off a little longer, safe travels! Remember to let the office know when you return so that we can correct mailing addresses and update caretaker information.





#### Reminders for All Residents and their Guests.

I am seeing an increasing number of vehicles clearly driving over the community Speed Limit. Per the Rules and Regulations and painted in huge letters/numbers on the streets, the **Speed Limit throughout the community is 15MPH. Please slow it down.** No one wants to be involved in any accidents involving pedestrians, golf carts, or bicycles.

#### Stay Alert. Hurricane season is not over.

Although the hurricane season for Florida has been eerily quiet, we are not in the clear yet, we have two more months.



#### Sealing Project Update



All roads in the community have been sealed, first by applying a thick layer that was squeegeed into the cracks and followed by a sprayed on top layer. As of this writing, our contractors are on property finishing up with cosmetic repairs.

#### **Friendly Reminder:**

Pool hours are dawn to dusk. Local ordinances and posted community rules are imposed for safety reasons. Our pool does not have lights required for night swimming as outlined in the Florida Administrative Code. Night swimming is defined as one to one and a half hours before sunset. Please do not give staff a hard time and follow state code. We do not want a fine.

#### HEY, MISTER! WHAT ARE YOU DOING BEHIND MY HOUSE?

At the rear of each home is a water meter which has an "end point" that sends usage information to a program that can be reviewed in the office. This enables us to detect leaks in order to minimize damage to your home and reduces the community water expenses. Over the next month, we will have several gentlemen performing maintenance on the end points, testing and replacing non-functioning units.

We will not be contacting individual residents as this will not interfere with water availability.

<u>Friendly Reminder:</u> It's time, once again, to spruce up outdoors. Take a walk around the exterior of your home and make a to-do list.

If you plan on <u>making changes</u> to the exterior, such as paint color, new windows/doors, or an architectural change, make sure you are submitting the "Request to Make Additions or <u>Changes Form</u>". The Board has implemented a \$500 fine for changes made without approval. Changes without approval are subject to removal/tear down, at your expense.

If you plan to perform maintenance, that <u>does</u> not include any changes, you will need to submit to management the "<u>Notice of Planned Maintenance</u>" form. As long as it is replaced/repaired with the same, Management can approve and work can begin without delay.






