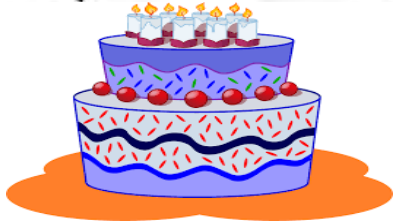

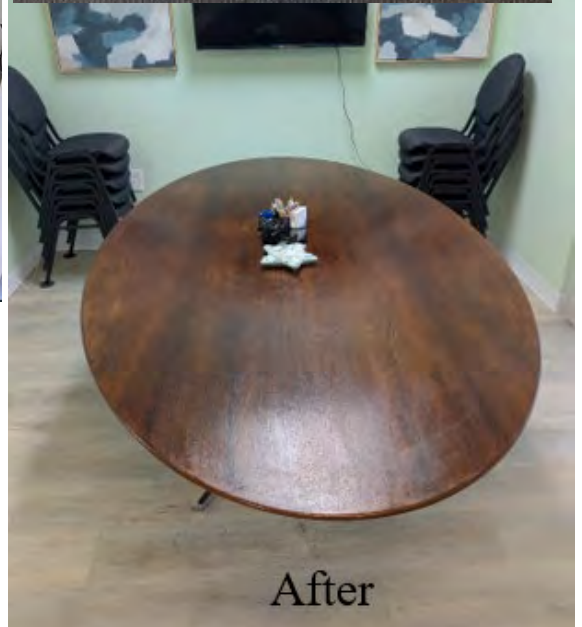

### Recipe Corner

#### LEMON PRETZEL DESSERT

2  $\frac{3}{4}$  Cups Crushed Pretzels

1  $\frac{1}{4}$  Cup Granulated Sugar

$\frac{3}{4}$  Cup Butter

12 oz. Cream Cheese

16 oz. Cool Whip

22 oz Can of Lemon Pie Filling

Mix together pretzels, sugar & butter press into bottom of 9X13 pan. Bake for 10 minutes. COOL COMPLETELY!

Beat cream cheese and cool whip, pour over crust. CHILL! Pour lemon pie filling over cream cheese layer. Chill at least 4 hours or overnight.

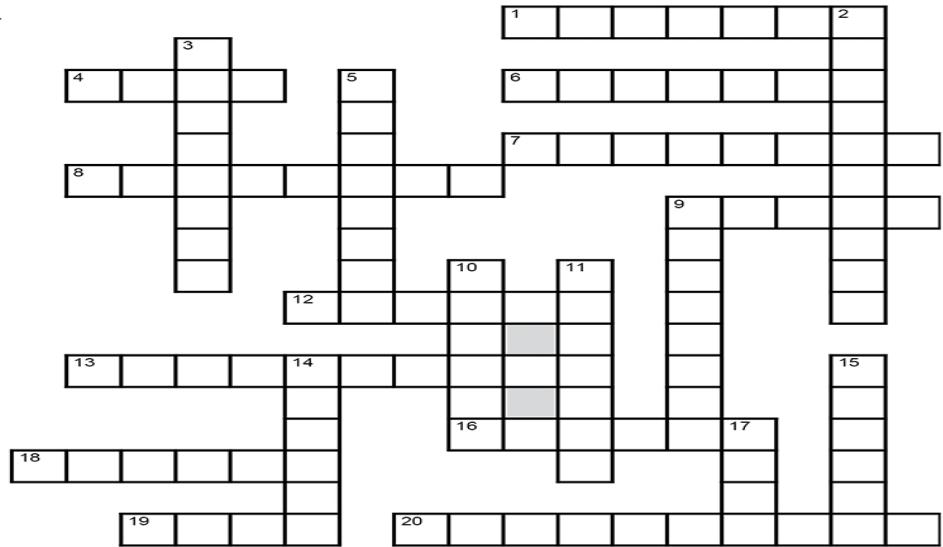
