The 30-30 Rule for Pools

The **30-30 rule** is the standard lightning safety protocol for swimming pools and other outdoor aquatic facilities. It is recommended by the **National Lightning Safety Council**, **National Weather Service**, and **American Lifeguard Association** to protect swimmers from the dangers of lightning strikes.

1. **First 30 seconds** – If you see lightning and hear thunder within **30 seconds**, the storm is close enough to be dangerous. Use the **flash-to-bang** method: count seconds between seeing lightning and hearing thunder. Every 5 seconds $\approx$ 1 mile away. At 30 seconds, lightning is about 6 miles away — still in the danger zone.
2. **Second 30 minutes** – After the last thunderclap or lightning flash, **wait at least 30 minutes** before resuming swimming

Please watch the weather forecast and watch the sky. If a storm is approaching, please act accordingly and seek shelter indoors. Do not stay in the pool.

Tired of Fighting the Yard Grass?

Stonehedge Architectural Guidelines allows owners to replace their grass with a permeable covering, such as stone and artificial turf. You may even consider installing a patio with pavers or bricks to expand your living area and eliminate the grass at the rear of your home. If you are interested in finding out more about these options, please review the Architectural Guidelines included with each “Request to Make Additions or Changes Form” available on the table outside the office, on the Stonehedge website and in the Owners Portal documents section.

Additions, Changes and Maintenance 101

It won't be long before the weather starts cooling and the list of exterior projects begins. A few helpful hints to make sure you are "doing it the right way".

- **General maintenance** issues like touching up paint or repairs with like materials only requires a "Planned Maintenance Form" to be completed and approved by the Manager. This is relatively quick and painless.

- **Material changes** to the exterior of your home will require the "Request to Make Additions or Changes Form", which will need to be recommended to the Board of Directors by the Architectural Advisory Group. The Board meets twice a month, September to May, with approval/denial issued at the scheduled meetings.

Information needed to avoid delays in approvals: Diagrams with measurements, highlight areas of change, include pictures of before and samples of materials to be used (can be digital format). Add as much detail as possible to your description of work to avoid confusion. If you see another home in the park that has something similar to what you would like to do, take a picture and include with your request. And last, but not least, contact your Manager or an Architectural Advisory Group member for advice.

Recipe Corner

CRISPY FLAT BREAD

Flatbread (10-12 inches)

Brie Cheese 4 oz

Dried Cranberries ¼ cup

Toasted Walnuts ¼ cup

Olive Oil 1 Tbsp

Hot Honey 1 Tbsp

Fresh Thyme Leaves (optional)

Preheat oven to 400. Line a baking sheet with parchment paper to keep flatbread crisp and easy to remove. Brush flatbread lightly with olive oil.

Layer the toppings: Place the brie slices evenly over the flatbread, followed by cranberries and toasted walnuts. Keep a little space between toppings for even melting and crunch.

Bake in oven for 8 to 10 minutes until cheese melts and edges turn golden brown. Once out of oven drizzle with hot honey. Sprinkle with fresh thyme.
