The Beacon is available in color electronically at stonehedgeonthehill.org. It will be available in a box placed at the mailboxes and inside Clubhouse.

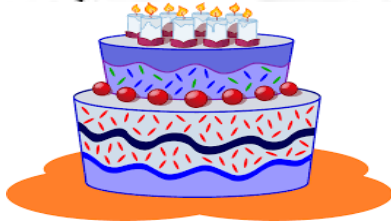

Irrigation Enforcement

By now I am sure you have heard that Pinellas County is under a **Phase III Water Shortage Order** as declared by the Southwest Florida Waste Management District (SWFWMD) and has restricted watering hours. These restrictions will **go into effect Friday, April 3rd**. **Tarpon Springs Code Enforcement** has stated they will not be issuing warnings and that the fine(s) will be in the range of **\$300 to \$500 per offense**.

Watering hours have been reduced to either **12:01am to 4:00 am** OR **8:00pm to 11:59pm, not both**. It is **suggested** that **run times** per zone be reduced to **35 minutes**. If code enforcement finds irrigation running at a time other than allowed per the new restrictions, they will be "leaving violations on the unit door without discussion". If your irrigation timer has not been changed, please contact the office for assistance.

Per Stonehedge Lot Irrigation/Sprinkler System Policy

The **ONLY** sprinkler system maintenance that **Residents** (or anyone other than SRI staff maintenance) should be doing is: **Replacing broken heads, Testing timers, Cleaning heads, Filters, Nozzle Screens and Doughnuts**.

Repairs that involve **Diaphragms, Valves, or Solenoids** should be referred to the office or submitted on a Work Request to the office for **Maintenance Staff** to address.

Any work on the **main lines** are to be performed **ONLY by Maintenance Staff**.

All parts replaced by SRI maintenance are charged to the homeowner at cost.

Please contact the office if you have any questions regarding irrigation repairs, maintenance, or run time issues.

Recipe Corner

ASIAN SALAD

2 Cups of cooked boneless chicken breast, diced into bite size pieces. (Can also use a rotisserie chicken with skin removed)

2 or 3 heads of Romaine lettuce chopped. (Bagged romaine will work as well)

One bunch of green onions, chopped

One 3 oz. of LaChoy Asian Style Crunch Noodles (rice noodles)

$\frac{3}{4}$ to 1 cup slivered almonds.

DRESSING: Mix the following ingredients in a jar and shake until blended. You will need to shake again before adding it to the salad. Many times I double this recipe depending on how many people I am serving. You may not use all of it.

4 Tablespoons sugar
2 teaspoons salt
 $\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoon pepper
4 teaspoons white vinegar
1 Tablespoon poppy seeds

* I add the Asian noodles, almonds and dressing just ahead of serving

Unit 217 Druid Circle

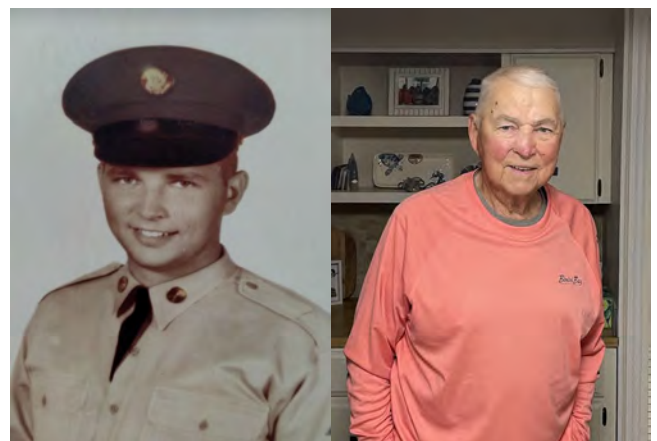
