Washout by retention pond was an emergency and needed immediate repair at a cost of \$3600.00. A motion was made to approve the repair and was approved. The Long-Term Planning Committee will work with the city on a plan to remediate this situation in the future.

General Park Discussion:

In response to a letter sent to the Board about the Clubhouse maintenance employee the Board is in support of the employee and his position unless a replacement must be considered in the future.

Firepit Rules are very clear and must be followed.

Facebook posts are for social posting and not for official notices. Sod Purchases are tabled for now.

The Clubhouse is not a hurricane shelter and though it remains open it is not endorsed by the Board.

For safety reasons please lock your doors, cars and sheds.

An official vote on the Pavilion was requested and the Long-Term Planning Committee will work on the proposal which requires a $\frac{2}{3}$ approval vote.

The Park Manager discussed the addition of a third dumpster when it is added, removed and the cost. Also discussed was the residents request for leaf removal from areas of the park and the possible purchase of a leaf vacuum and the cost.

Unit 61 suggested that the signs in the park be straightened for a better look.
